Invention: A new and useful process, device, article of manufacture, or composition of matter, or new or useful improvement upon one of these.

Innovation: is an evolutionary process of increasing the capability to apply a technology, applying in new contexts, expanding the capability of a technology or improving the capability of a product.

Patent: The creation of a new technical idea and of the physical means to accomplish or embody it. To be patentable, an invention must be novel, have utility, and differ from what skilled users might expect.
